

# ABSENTEE VOTERS

If you will be unable to get to your polling location on Election Day November 4, 2014, between the hours of 6 a.m. and 6 p.m., there are multiple options for absentee voting.

You may request a paper absentee ballot application from your County Clerk's office in person, by mail, or by phone. Tuesday October 28, is the last day to apply for a mail-in absentee ballot. The application **MUST** be received in my office on that day. After I receive your signed application I will then mail your ballot to you. Mail-in absentee ballots must be returned to the county clerk no later than Election Day, November 4, 2014.

If you don't qualify for a paper ballot, you may be able to vote in person on the voting machine during regular working hours.
